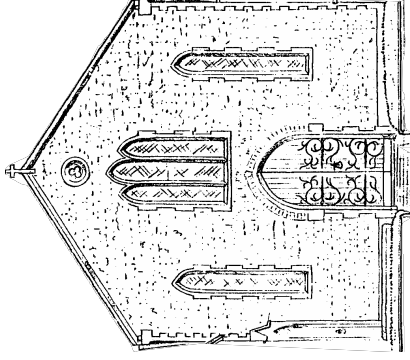
Why not join us for our Circuit Service here,
